## PACKING LIST

### Required

- Variety of approved clothing (warm and cool, nice and play)
- Approved active and swim wear
- Hat/bandana (required for kitchen work assignment)
- Bible, notebook/journal, and pen
- Medications and health care needs
- Toiletries—soap, shampoo, toothbrush/paste, etc.
- Towels- daily use & beach.
- Bedding (for twin bed) or sleeping bag
- Pillow
- Variety of comfortable shoes such as sandals and tennis shoes. Closed-toe shoes are required for kitchen duty (i.e. tennis shoes). Keep in mind they'll be well-used while here.
- Money for coin laundry (quarters) and detergent (may also be purchased at Camp)
  
- If not already on file with Life Action, appropriate original documents for the I-9 Form***  
(See "List of Acceptable Documents," page 5, of the I-9 paperwork for additional details)

### What Not to Bring

- Computer/Tablet/iPad
- Fireworks
- Game systems (Wii, Xbox, PS3, etc.)

### Optional Items

- Sunglasses/Sunscreen
- Bug repellent
- Extra spending money (for outings)
- Fishing gear
- Rain jacket
- Shower caddy
- Laundry bag
- Flashlight
- Water bottle
- Alarm clock
